AWARDS: ESRI offers grants to states supporting ten equal prizes of \$100 for the five best high school and five best middle school projects in the state. Schools can submit up to five projects to the state, and participating states submit to ESRI the ten awardees (5-HS and 5-MS), with one project each at high school and middle school tagged for a final level of competition.

One high school project and one middle school project will earn a trip to the 2021 ESRI Education Conference in San Diego, CA.
